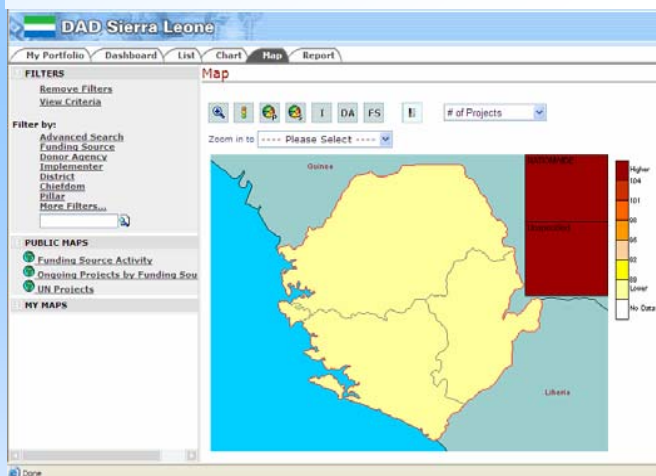

Improving aid data through the Development Assistance Database

“The Government requires all partners to report to the Development Assistance Database, and comply with its Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), reporting on their aid inflows in a timely, accurate and comprehensive manner.” The Sierra Leone Aid Policy (2009)

In 2008 the Government of Sierra Leone installed a Development Assistance Database (DAD). Data is inputted by development partners themselves and can be analysed by multiple fields, including sector, district and type of organisation. GoSL is committed to using the DAD as its main repository for aid information in order to allow for better quality of aid analysis. 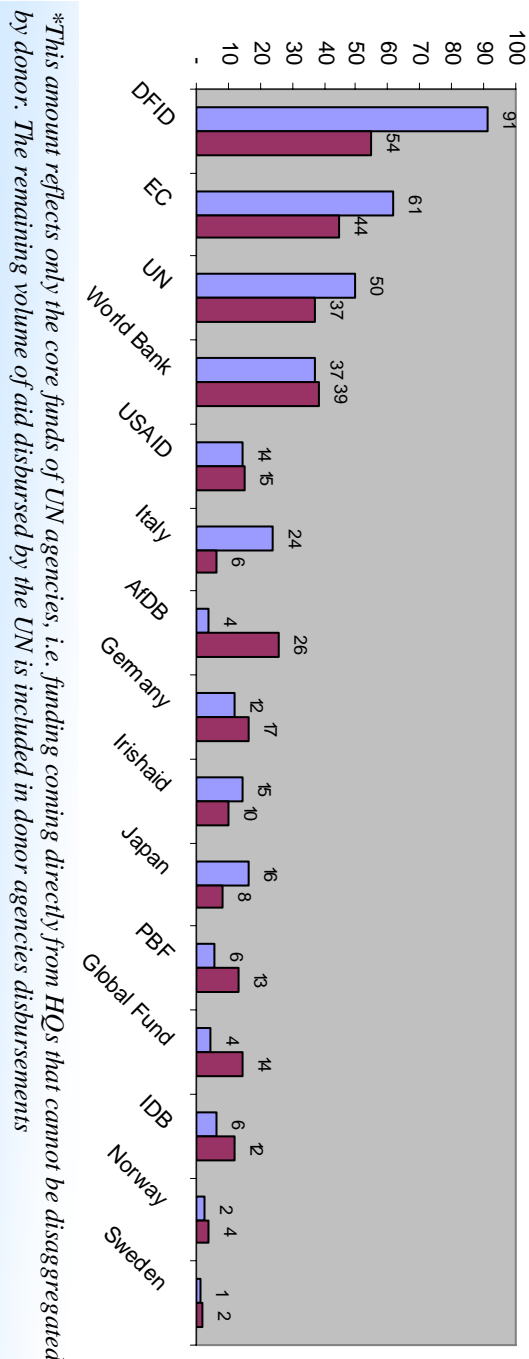

Top 15 Reported Disbursing Agencies/ Donors 2007—2008 (UN Represents “Core” Funding* only) (\$m) Disbursed



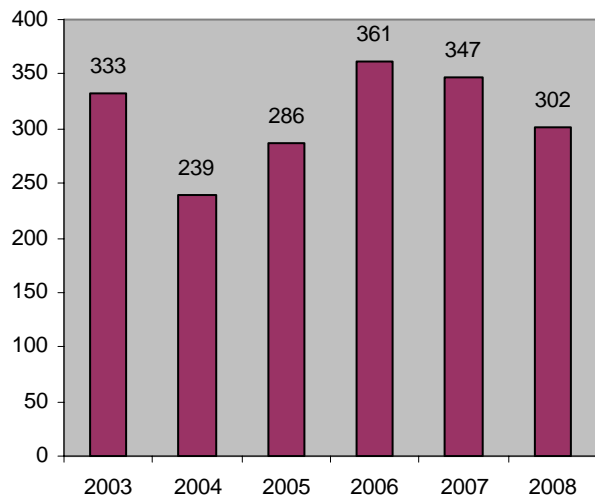

Data Source and Verification Processes

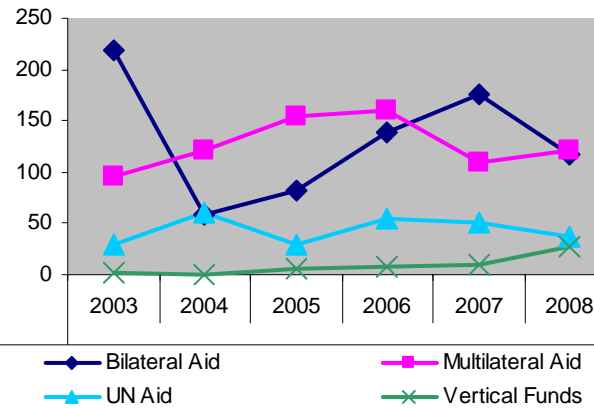
All data analysed within this pamphlet derives from reporting from development partners. Pre-2007 data was sourced from Development Assistance Reports, which are based on partner reporting. From 2007 onwards, the data was captured through information reported on the Government of Sierra Leone's (GoSL) main repository for aid information, the Development Assistance Database (DAD). Data is provided directly onto the system by development partners, and the system is administered by GoSL. For more information, see back page.

Prior to finalisation and analysis, a multi-stage verification process was undertaken. Reported data was circulated to all donors in-country, and Government institutions (MDAs), in excel format

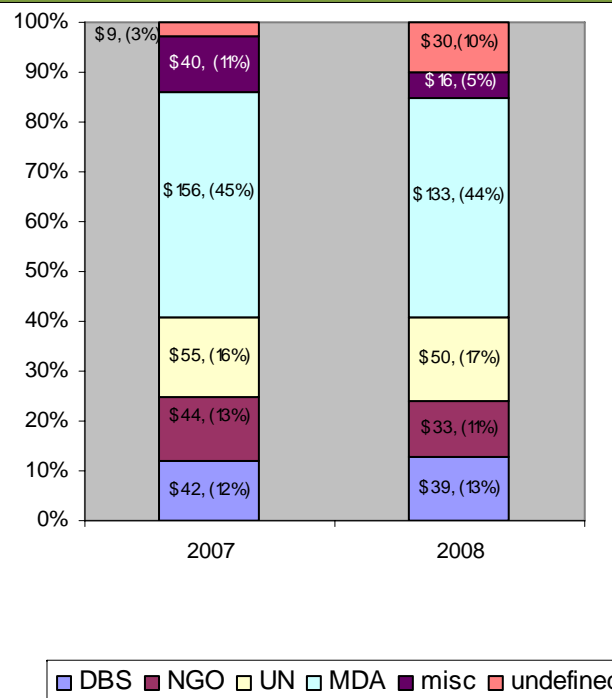
Development Assistance Disbursed 2003—2008 (\$m)



Reported Development Assistance by Type 2003—2008 (\$m Disbursed)

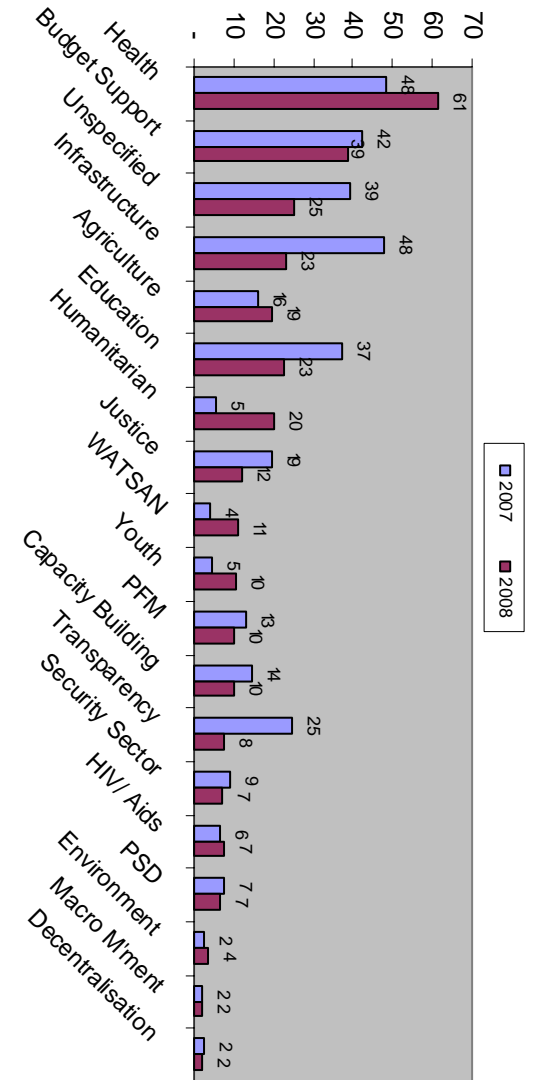


Changes to Aid Implementer 2007—2008 (by primary reported implementer)
